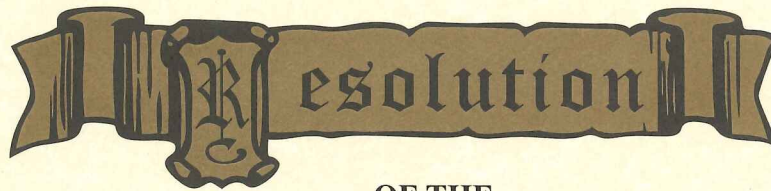

Whereas, Sonoma County and the State of California benefit economically from a scientifically literate workforce; and


Whereas, cultivating a scientific workforce starts with providing young people opportunities to spark wonder and curiosity in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM); and
